

Residents in Connoquenessing Woodlands Lose Their Water

Evans City, PA, February 29, 2012—Rex Energy informed residents of The Woodlands of Connoquenessing Township, Butler County that water deliveries supplying them with clean, safe water would cease on February 29, 2012. The water deliveries replaced water that became contaminated after natural gas drilling activities began in the area.



Pictured here, the water delivery company is emptying and removing one of the two water buffaloes supplying three households with potable water at a home on Hawk Drive. The residents are concerned that they must return to using the contaminated well water, seen in the photos below, which prompted their original complaints.



Another area household had its buffalo removed the preceding day, a day earlier than the homeowner had been informed by Rex. The residents of the home are staying with family members due to the difficulties of caring for their newborn with a limited water supply. Three other households are retaining their buffaloes and water deliveries at their own expense of \$125 weekly or more.
